A few things have changed, let us tell you more



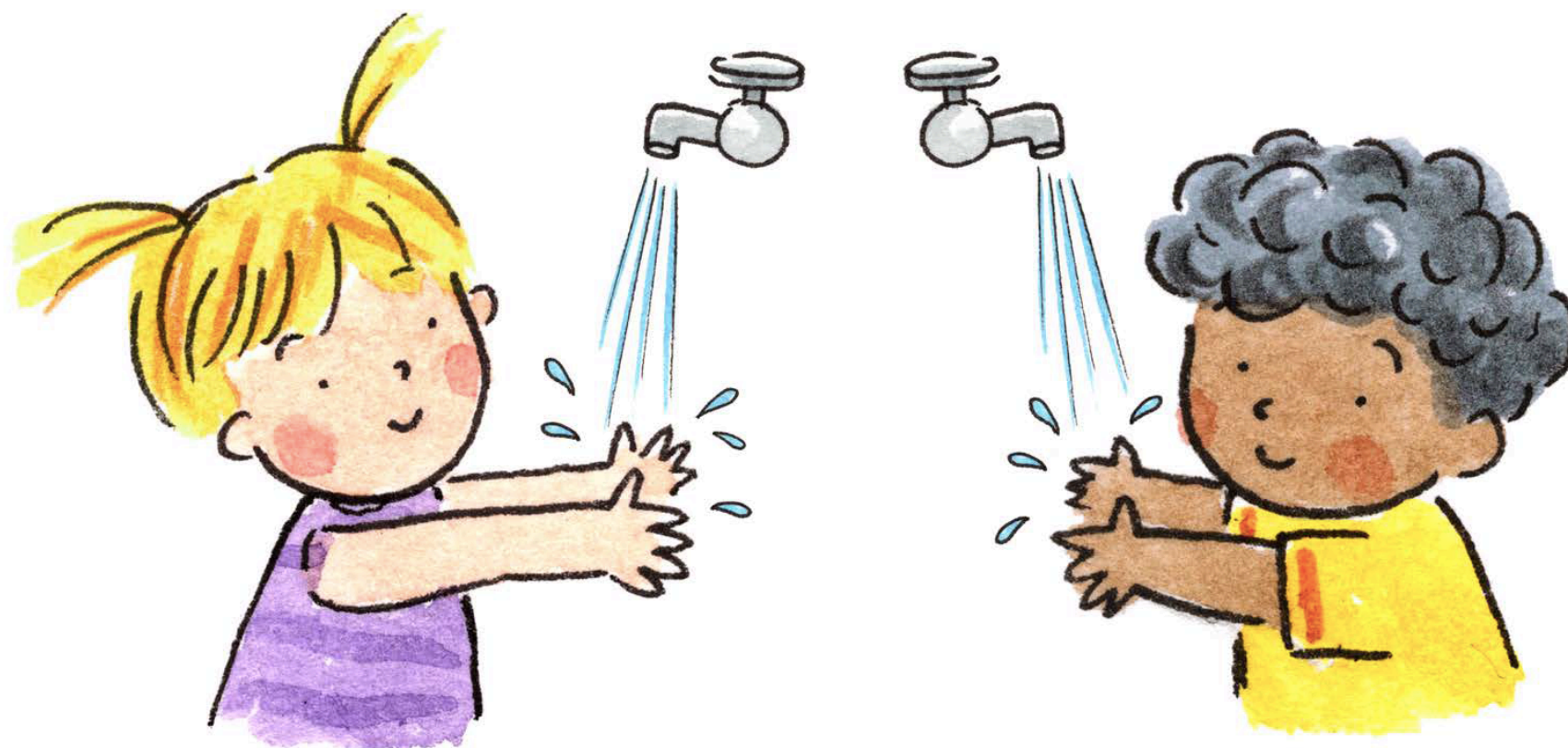
You may have to queue when you get to the gate,
